A sweeping and suspenseful novel of love and war, set in Japan during the tense final weeks of WWII, that calls to mind classic bestsellers of yesteryear—think *Cold Mountain*, *From Here to Eternity*, *Gone with the Wind*—and comes with an incredible backstory that rivals those of Karl Marlantes (*Matterhorn*) and T. J. Newman (*Falling*): The author, now 63 years old, persevered over 28 years and five rewrites to complete and publish this book.

War has taken everything from physicist Keizo Kan. His young daughter was killed in the Great Tokyo Air Raid, and now his Japanese-American wife, Noriko, has been imprisoned by the brutal Thought Police. An American bomber, downed over Japan on the first day of August 1945, offers the scientist a surprising chance at salvation. The Imperial Army dispatches him to examine an unusual device recovered from the plane's wreckage—a bomb containing uranium—and tells him that if he can unlock its mysteries, his wife will be released. Working in secrecy under crushing pressure, Kan begins to disassemble the bomb and study its components. Desperate to stave off Japan's surrender to the Allies, the army will stop at nothing to harness the weapon's unimaginable power.

Samuel Hawley is a Canadian writer with BA and MA degrees in history from Queen's University in Kingston, Ontario. He was born and grew up in South Korea and taught English there and in Japan for many years. He currently lives in Istanbul, Turkey.

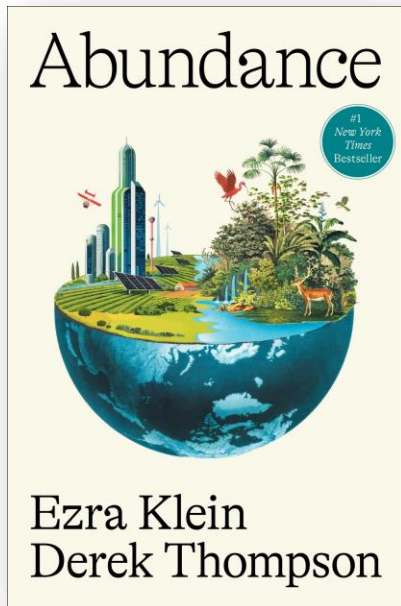

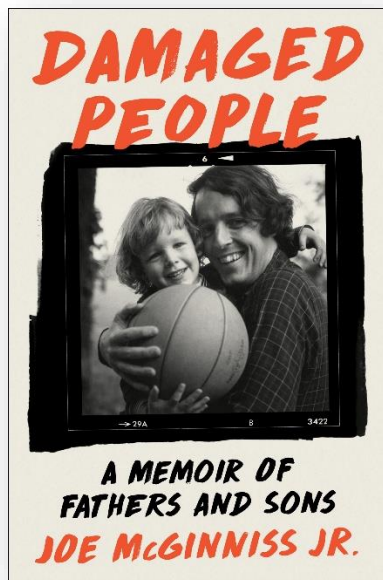

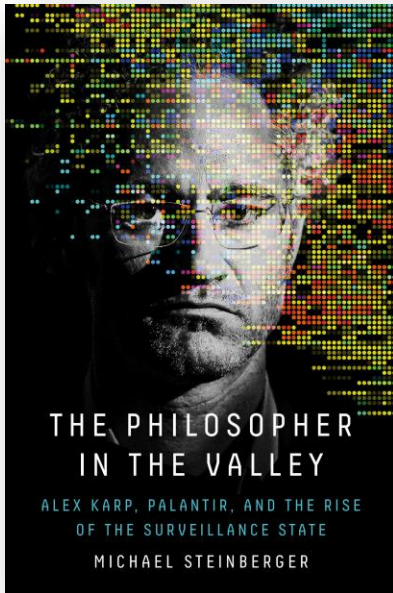

Go to Palantir’s website and you are greeted by the kind of anodyne techno-utopianism that is de rigeur at annual stockholders’ meetings and Apple Stores. But what is Palantir? In the not-entirely-hyperbolic words of its billionaire CEO, it is “the de facto operating system of the West’s most vital institutions.” Named by co-founder Peter Thiel after the palantír seeing stones of Tolkien’s *Lord of the Rings*, Palantir is an unrivalled data mining behemoth that is run by one of the most unconventional and heterodox CEO’s to be found among the Davos global elite, Alex Karp. What are those “vital institutions” using Palantir to “change the world for the better”? The CIA, MI6, Mossad, ICE, all the branches of the US military, the SEC, the IRS, the CDC, the executive branch, BP, Airbus, the World Health Organization, the World Food Programme. Unlike its household-name peers—Meta, Apple, Microsoft, Amazon, and Alphabet—Palantir rarely makes a splash outside of the business pages. Even though its business is us. Steinberger will for the first time illuminate the paradoxical and idiosyncratic figure who is as consequential to the security of our democracy and our information as anyone in in the world of technology or government.

Michael Steinberger is the perfect candidate to write this book. He has Karp’s implicit trust. He has written important profiles for the *Times Magazine* about Joe Biden and George Soros and has written about business for *The Times* of London and *The Financial Times*. He is also a James Beard Award-winning wine writer (he’s the author of two books about food and wine culture), and covers tennis for the *NYT*, including his excellent recent A1 overview of the Djokovic-Australia contretemps.

A singularly funny and moving memoir about the author's great-grandmother, who considered herself married to a ghost with whom she had ecstatic sex for 40 years until her death at 103, and the recordings she left behind—the effects of which the author follows through her eccentric family and into her own unconventional coming-of-age.

At the heart of *Spirited* is a haunting in Levittown, Long Island. That the ghost visiting Alia's great-grandmother Paula was having daily ecstatic sexual encounters with her didn't make it any easier to believe. But believe it Paula did. For nearly forty years, she considered herself married to the ghost of a former lover named Ed Clayton—and even changed her legal name to Paula Long-Clayton. Paula, who lived to 103, communicated with Ed through a Ouija Board, but their primary interactions were sexual. Paula documented her supernatural romance in an audio-journal on cassette tape, which she gave to Alia on their last visit together. Then, after Alia fell in love and began to think about starting her own family, she came across a Sony Walkman in a thrift store with a note taped to it that read, "It works." Listening to her great-grandmother's account six years after her death prompted a series of discoveries and breakthroughs about being a woman, a mother, and a daughter, that changed the way Alia understood her family and what was possible for herself.

Alia Volz is the author of the memoir *Home Baked: My Mom, Marijuana, and the Stoning of San Francisco*, winner of the Golden Poppy Award for Nonfiction from the California Independent Bookseller Alliance and finalist for the National Book Critics Circle Award in Autobiography. Her work has been published in *The Best American Essays*, *The New York Times*, *Bon Appetit*, *Salon*, *Tin House*, and *The Best Women's Travel Writing*. Esther Perel's *Mating in Captivity* (2006; sold in more than 20 international markets) and Chris Ryan's *Sex at Dawn* (2010) exposed the cracks in our modern monogamy-only relationship model and unlocked the door to the rest of the relationship landscape. But neither showed us how to find our way around. In fact, more than 10 years later, in her 2017 book, *The State of Affairs: Rethinking Infidelity*, Perel told us "Few social scripts exist. We are all improvising."

Vrangalova wants readers to do more than just improvise. "How do we find the relationship type that's right for us, and how do we make sure we're doing it well? Science finally has some concrete answers. All humans have two basic needs: security and exploration. To survive, we need to be physically and emotionally safe and secure; to grow, we need to be able to seek new experiences, to be challenged and surprised." Vrangalova offers insights on how to pursue both.

Zhana Vrangalova, PhD is a NYC-based sex and relationships consultant, speaker, and writer who is passionate about elevating our conversations about love and relationships. She holds a PhD in Developmental Psychology from Cornell University and teaches human sexuality courses at New York University.
