## Mussolini's Ghost

### The Afterlife of a Dictator

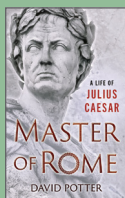
**STEPHEN GUNDLE**, Professor of Film and Television Studies, University of Warwick

This book explores the strange and enduring afterlife of Italy's Fascist dictator. Although Mussolini was executed in 1945 and publicly repudiated, his presence lingered in Italian culture, politics, and memory. He remained visible through the activism of his family, the work of the mass media, and in monuments and statues, symbolizing ideas about masculinity, national identity, and political leadership.

Gundle argues that the root causes of Mussolini's persistence lie in the ways Italians negotiated the transition from war to peace and from Fascism to democracy. Instead of acknowledging the enthusiastic backing many had given to a criminal dictatorship, many Italians behaved as though Fascism had never really existed. Mussolini was re-cast as a flawed but well-meaning family man, allowing his image to persist in popular culture, film, television, and political discourse. As a result, the grip Mussolini established over the popular mind was never properly dismantled.

- Provides a novel analysis of the posthumous resonances of a well-known dictator and explores the long cultural aftermath of Italian Fascism
- Offers a new way of examining postwar Italy and its culture, using sources from cinema, television, material culture, literature, and politics
- Analyses the psychological and cultural factors behind Mussolini's persistence, drawing on psychoanalysis and collective psychology, and compares Italy's struggle to reckon with its Fascist past to Germany's confrontation with Nazism

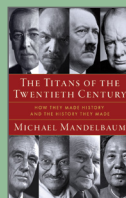

## Markets of Pain

### Opium, Capitalism, and the Global History of Painkillers

**BENJAMIN ROBERT SIEGEL**, Associate Professor of History, Boston University

For centuries, opium has been a source of both profit and peril, its legacy entangled with addiction, imperialism, and the complex interplay of global trade and national development. While the illicit opium trade is infamous, the history of licit opium has remained largely untold.

Drawing on archival sources from Asia, Europe, and the United States, this book traces the global arc of licit opium from poppy fields and processing plants, to the clinics and laboratories of modern medicine. It shows how both the Ottoman Empire and the Turkish Republic leveraged the crop to secure global stature, while India initially rejected its imperial legacy before embracing opium's geopolitical value during the Cold War. At the heart of this story are the cultivators, scientists, bureaucrats, and policymakers who shaped the licit opium trade and grappled with its far-reaching consequences. Their decisions demonstrate how colonial empires and postcolonial states helped forge the global pharmaceutical industry as it struggled to govern a drug it could not abandon.

Siegel reveals how a seemingly marginal crop became an unlikely engine of modernization, a tool of Cold War geopolitics, and a harbinger of today's global opioid crisis.

- Reframes the history of legal opium as a driver of global capitalism, medicine, and state power
- Traces the opium economy across India, Turkey, and Australia to show how postcolonial states shaped the global pharmaceutical industry
- Unpacks the competing agenda of farmers, chemists, and bureaucrats who sustained the legal opium trade

## How Europe Survives

### The Adaptability and Resilience of a Continent in Peril

From the eurozone crisis and Brexit to the pandemic and war, Europe has faced many challenges. And yet, it endures. Not because it has resolved its contradictions, but because it has adapted through them.

This book reframes Europe as a living organism: imperfect, evolving, and responsive to its environment. It survives by improvising, recalibrating, and absorbing tensions and external shocks. Its strengths lie in its malleability and flexibility, which enable it to constantly reinvent itself. At the same time, the authors avoid romanticizing Europe's history, acknowledging the inequalities and external dependencies that persist.

The result is both a reinterpretation of Europe's past and a guide to its future. It offers a practical lesson for governing in an age of permanent crisis: flexible institutions, open contestation, and a willingness to learn can keep a political project alive.

### Russia, China, and Turkey Challenging Regional Order

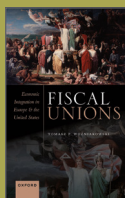

Europe used to be an agenda-setter at the global level, but is now on the backfoot, facing rising populism internally and pressures from Russia, China, Turkey, and the U.S. that are undermining the European Union's cohesion and international influence.
